
Glenbrook and Holbrook Maps with street names



Glenbrook boundary changes


- Area 1 is the area north of the 4 highway and includes Clyde
- Area 2 is bordered by the 4 on the north, the 242 on the east, and Solano Way on the south/west. Houses on the north/east side of Solano are in area 2.
- Area 3 is bordered by the 4 on the north, the 242 on the west, and Willow Pass on the south/east
- Area 4 is bordered on the north/east by Solano Way (houses on the south/west side of Solano Way are in area 4), on the east side of the 242 the east border is Grant St, and the south boundary is Clayton Rd with houses on the north side of Clayton Rd in area 4
- Area 5 is bordered by Clayton Rd on the north, Galindo on the east, Walters on the south, and Meadow on the west

Recommendation

- Based on parent input Area 1 should attend Valley View – this input was based on using public transportation
- Areas 2 & 3 should attend El Dorado
- Area 4 should attend Valley View
- Area 5 should attend Oak Grove

Glenbrook Parent Concern

- Primary concern is transportation
 - Currently, it takes two buses to get to EI Dorado MS on County Connections and students would have to transfer at the Concord BART station.
 - At a cost of \$21,500 per run (round trip) we could provide transportation from Sun Terrace, Wren, or Glenbrook to El Dorado or Valley View. Therefore, if we charge \$400 annually for a bus pass we would pay for the transportation costs if we averaged 53 students per bus. We could work out a payment plan of \$40 a month for a bus pass.
 - County Connections costs \$4 a day round trip or \$720 annually. Therefore, we could save our families \$320 annually and provide a direct route to the schools.
 - We have had a conversation with Contra Costa 5-11 and they may be able to provide parents vouchers as an incentive to take the school district bus.
 - We could also run a late bus for students in the after school program at El Dorado, or if approved by the State expand the after school programs at Wren and Sun Terrace to include 6-8 graders.



Holbrook boundary changes

- Area 1 is bordered by Solano Way on the north and the 242 on the east
- Area 2 follows the current Holbrook borders on the north and south, the 242 on the west, and Port Chicago Hwy on the east
- Area 3 is bordered by Port Chicago on the west, Olivera on the east (students on the south/east side of Olivera are in area 3), and the current Holbrook border on the south
- Area 4 is north/east of Olivera and south of Port Chicago Hwy, and follows the current Holbrook borders to the east and south

Recommendations

- Areas 1 and 4 will attend Sun Terrace
- Areas 2 and 3 will attend Wren
- From Richard Ave it is 1.9 miles to either Holbrook or Sun Terrace, and 2.4 miles to Wren
- From Ann St. to Holbrook it is 1.5 miles to Wren it is 1.7 miles
- From Ida St to Wren it is 1.2 miles
